WEDDING CEREMONY

Do I need a permit for beach ceremony? The beach immediately in front of the resort is owned by the resort, so no city permit is required. There is a \$1250.00 beach ceremony fee payable to the hotel in order to secure an open area for your ceremony as well as weather back up space inside. This fee does not include any decor items. No power is available at the beach. We have a list of preferred vendors that are wonderful resources for these items.

What times can we host a beach ceremony? In respect to the other guests that enjoy our beach, and so that you have the best possible experience, we recommend beach ceremonies prior to 9:30am and one hour prior to sunset. During special events and holidays, we do not host beach ceremonies. These include, but are not limited to, President's Day weekend, Memorial Day weekend, the 4th of July, New Year's Eve & New Year's Day.

What other restrictions apply to a beach ceremony? Rice, bird seed and other items may not be thrown during a beach ceremony. All amplified sound cannot be overly loud. All chair and decor items must be removed immediately after the ceremony

When must the decision be made to move an outdoor event inside? Two hours prior to the start of your function a decision must be made in regards to moving an event due to weather. This decision will be made with the guest, hotel banquet manager and catering manager.

Other than the beach, what outdoor ceremony options are there? The City of Deerfield Beach offers rental of their Observation Deck at the International Fishing Pier complex. This deck sits above the beach on the second level of the complex offering vast views of the ocean and pier. It is fully accessible with stairs and an elevator. It is rented in four hour increments. The Observation Deck **does** require a permit from the City of Deerfield Beach.

Can I take pictures the International Fishing Pier? Other than the beach, what outdoor ceremony options are there? The historic Deerfield Beach International Fishing Pier, the longest on the Atlantic coast, is operated by the City of Deerfield Beach. There is a fee of \$1 per person to enter the pier. Photography is welcome but no area can be blocked off specifically for photos.

What are the options for parking for my guests? Valet and self- parking are available at the resort. Self-parking for your event is \$10 per car and valet parking is \$15. For overnight guests, self- parking is \$17 per car per night and valet is \$22 per car per night.
