I like simple. My pricing reflects this.

\$200.00 per hour. No minimum or maximum. This puts you in control. Some clients want full coverage. Bride prep, the ceremony, group shots, romantics and full reception coverage. Others may want photography for just the ceremony, group shots, romantics and an hour at the reception. You decide how many hours you want photographed.



I don't take deposits as I like to get paid when I work. This seems to work well for myself and the client. This way if you have to cancel for any reason, there's no messy situations of you trying to get a retainer back. It happens. I try to keep it simple for both parties.

Why so cheap? I get asked this all the time. This is what I would pay for wedding photography. Digital has made this relatively easy for an experienced photographer. (Note I said "experienced"). I live simply, I'm not trying to get rich, I truly love photographing weddings and I'd rather be busy than only doing 15 weddings a year.



Experience? I've been a professional photographer for about 17 years. I've photographed many many weddings in the area and overseas. I work part time in a local camera store. I'm part owner of a local studio and I'm part owner of a film lab. I shoot digital for weddings as it makes sense, but for much of my personal work I shoot large format film.

Payment? Simple. When I'm finished photographing your wedding, we'll add up the hours. You can either pay me in cash or I can take a credit card onsite.
