I prefer to keep my pricing as simple and straightforward as possible to make it easier for everyone! No collections or packages, just pick what you want and add it all up! I understand that every wedding is different and can be flexible to accommodate your needs, so please don't hesitate to reach out.

## PRICES

\$3500 - Full day photography coverage, includes all the high resolution images (with printing rights), online gallery from which to buy prints at cost, a USB drive and my guidance with building your timeline for your wedding day

\$1000 - Elopements - ceremony coverage and 2 hour portrait session (Monday - Thursday only)

\$300 - Film Add-On! This allows me to shoot a mixture of film and digital

\$700 - Second photographer

\$350 - Engagement Session if I am shooting your wedding, if not \$450

\$1200 - High-end, heirloom quality 10" x 10" Album.

\$300 - 6" x 6" Parent Album (same design as the Couple's album)

## FAQS

### **How do we book you?**

A contract plus a 50% retainer will reserve your wedding date with the remaining balance due 30 days before your wedding.

### **How long does it take to receive the photos?**

You will receive a gallery of a few standout photos from your day within one week of the wedding. Final delivery of all high-resolution edited photos is 6 weeks after your wedding.

### **Do you take formal/family photos?**

As much as I love the documentary/journalistic style, I understand the importance of family portraits. We will work together to create list of portraits you would like to make the process as simple as possible! Typically I recommend 30 minutes for immediate family portraits.

### **Do you travel for weddings?**

I am based out of Chicago, but frequently travel for weddings. Contact me for a quote to your destination!

### **Do you work with second shooters / assistants?**

I work on my own and with second photographers depending on the details and size of the wedding. Generally as a rule, weddings with a guest count over 150 guests I would recommend a second photographer, for less than, I feel confident photographing on my own, and often prefer it.
