

ENGAGEMENT SESSIONS


Natural, Intimate, Romantic

The key to a breathtaking engagement shoot is planning. Coordinate your outfits, your location, and any extra little details.

Meet with me to discuss your vision, and together we can create art that embodies your relationship. I love when a couple suggests having their photos taken in a spot that is sentimental to them, because it makes the shoot even more intimate and personal.

Professional hair and makeup is a great idea, and adding additional vendors, like a florist can add another element of beauty to your shoot.

If you need additional guideance, I am here to help!



WHAT TO WEAR

Wardrobe 101:

Wear what makes you feel confidant and comfortable. Some clients like to get dressed up, while others gravitate toward bold patterns or a more casual style. My goal is to capture you in your element, so feel free to get creative with your wardrobe! It's best to pay careful attention to the overall feel of your shoot and the location.

Planning Your Outfit:

While it is encouraged to compliment your future spouse in photos, by no means do the two of you need to wear matching outfits. If your other half is more comfortable in solid colors, try choosing something with a little texture. Patterns are a great way to add contrast to your images. Be creative and let your unique personality shine through!

What to Bring:

Using a vendor like a florist or a rental company can make your images more unique.

Scheduling:

Most sessions are scheduled one to two hours before sunset in order to capture the day's most beautiful, natural lighting. Inclement weather can be fun to work with, so if you want to brave any weather I'm always game. Weekends in Spring, Summer, or Fall are generally reserved for weddings.



Wedding Day Planning:

I am happy to be as involved as you want me to be in your planning. I can suggest locations, or weigh in on your ideas or timeline.

By planning more ahead of time, your day will run smoothly and efficiently.













On Your Wedding Day:

It is so important for a bride and groom to be relaxed and happy on the day of their wedding. The planning before the wedding is a vital part of a smooth wedding day. I will work with you to plan out a timeline that allows ample time for wedding day portraits, ensuring images that capture the real joy and emotions of your day.

Scheduling:

I will talk you through your
wedding day schedule as we plan
together, helping you decide on the
best timeline for your day. I can draw
from my extensive wedding experience
and my knowledge of your desires and
expectations of that day to create the
perfect schedule for you.





BEFORE YOUR WEDDING

Planning:

Our first meeting will be a get-to-know you meeting. Most likely you will be meeting with several photographers to determine who best fits your style and needs. If you decide to book with me, you will fill out a contract and submit a 30% retainer fee to officially book your date.

Next, we will discuss your engagement session. We'll talk about your style, what you want to do with the images (save the dates? guest book?). At the session, you'll experience my shooting style and how I direct you. When you receive your images, let me know if you don't like a certain angle or pose so I don't repeat it at your wedding!

About a month before your wedding, we'll sit down and work through all the final details. We'll talk about your your hopes and dreams for that day. We'll talk about your bridal party and go over some of the images you're hoping to get at your wedding. I have a list of shots I run through so I'm prepared for moments that are very important to you.

A week before your wedding, your final pament is due. Be sure to let me know about any last minute changes so that you're free to relax on your wedding day.



PORTRAITS

Family Photos + Group Shots

Aside from the candid and natural portraits taken throughout the day, most couples like to also include formal portraits with family.

The best time to do these formal family portraits is typically right before or after the ceremony, since family members are all in the same place at this time. Determine whether or not you'd like extended family photos (with uncles, aunts, and cousins) or just immediate family photos (just parents and siblings, or grandparents as well).

Crowd Management:

It helps to have a designated friend who can proactively gather the groups so I can focus on creating beautiful photos! Usually this person knows the groups pretty well, they have a loud voice, and they can round people up with ease.

More Recommendations:

If you choose to do family photos after the ceremony, have your officiant make an announcement asking family to stay in the ceremony location. Have an appointed friend help facilitate the different groups you would like to have photographed. This means that they have the list of family members and they are gathering people either with an extra loud voice or a handheld microphone.

Keep your list of groups short. Please note that each group shot can take 2-3 minutes. we would all love to have photos with every important person at the wedding, but time is of the essence. Less is more in this type of situation, and you will have the reception to get group shots if necessary.

By planning and discussing your decision with me ahead of time, you are destined for fun and smooth formal portraits!



















GETTING YOUR PHOTOS

Sneak Peeks:

I try to post images on Facebook or Instagram as I'm editing them. Let me know if you'd like to see your images on Social Media. It's so hard to wait for all your images to be ready, but this can help!

Completing Your Package:

Within 60 days after your wedding, you will receive an online gallery of several hundred images. From here, your friends and family can purchase digital images or prints. You can select the prints or canvases from your package at this time and favorite images for your album.

Products:

I will mail you your prints, and any other products you've selected, and you will receive them within a few weeks of ordering. After you favorite your images and let me know, I will begin designing your album.

You can include your wedding, engagement session, or bridal session! This is a great way to entertain guests in your new home (albums also make perfect gifts for the in-laws).

The Process:

Designing your album is really easy! Once you favorite the images you'd like included in your online album, I'll design your spreads and send the mockups over via email. You will have the chance to make two rounds of edits to the design. Additional edits are charged accordingly.

The Timeline:

There is a two month window to make edits after the initial design is sent over.
