EYE LASH EXTENSION RATES

Full Set of Lash Extensions (90-140 lashes/eye. Takes approximately 2 hours)	\$265
Tester Set (10-15 lashes/eye, Recommended for first time clients)	\$25
15 Minute Fill	\$30
30 Minute Fill (approximately 2 weeks since last application)	\$55
45 Minute Fill (approximately 3 weeks since last application).....	\$75
60 Minute Fill (approximately 4 weeks since last application)	\$100
Lash Extensions Removal	\$25-\$65

Add 15 minutes for lash prep. To make for a quicker appointment, do not wear any makeup. There may be an up charge if it takes more than 15 minutes to remove makeup.

In the 24-48 hours after your appointment

- Do NOT expose your lashes to water, heat, saunas, steam and friction.
- Cleanse the face with a washcloth, so there will not be any drippage on the lashes.
- Take a bath.
- If you must take a shower, make sure face does not come in contact with water. Keep water lukewarm to not create steam.
- Do not apply eye cosmetics or skin care products to your lashes or your eyelids during the first 24 hours.
- Always sleep on your back to avoid friction.
- Switching to satin pillow cases is recommended.
- Always keep oil based products AWAY from lashes. Do not use any waterproof makeup.
- Wait 48 hours after lash removal prior to having your new set of lashes applied.

Preparing for your lashes

- Please have clean lashes before your appointment. You will maximize your time with the lash stylist if they do not have to clean makeup off your eyelid and lashes.
- Do not curl your lashes.
- Contact lenses are not recommended during session.
- Shower and have your hair washed before having lashes applied because you do NOT want to get them wet for 48 hours.
- Do not apply heavy creams, lotions, or oils to your face within 48 hours prior to your lash application appointment.
- Consult with your Lash Stylist if you have recently had any irritating eye area treatments such as skin resurfacing procedures, chemical peels, eyebrow waxing, laser treatments, or permanent makeup application. Recovery time varies with each procedure and individual.
- Consult with your physician prior to your lash application appointment if you are pregnant, taking medication, suffer from any medical conditions or allergies, or recovering from any medical procedures.
