

It is my goal to help you to feel at home when we're together, so you when you look back at these images next year, in ten years, and in twenty years, you'll see images that are an authentic reflection of who you are as a couple in this season of your life together.

My affinity for heirlooms and nostalgia has led me to creating a unique hybrid approach for my wedding clients, using both digital and film mediums to curate fine-art inspired image collections. When I'm not photographing weddings, you can find me preparing a meal for my husband and two toddler boys, with harvest fresh from our garden, in the farmhouse we've renovated that's been in our family for generations. Connections of sentiment from my own life inspire the decisions I make behind the camera, translating into work for my clients that feels warm and authentic.

THE PROCESS

The Call

After you've reviewed the information in this guide, the next step is to schedule a phone call with me. This is a vital step, as this is where we'll get to know more about one another, you will share your vision for your wedding day, and you'll have the opportunity to ask me questions about my business and photography approach.

The Contract

If after the initial call we decide that we're a good fit to work together, we will make things official by signing a contract and securing an initial deposit of \$1500. This will reserve your date on my calendar as I take a limited number of events each year.

The Engagement Session

Once the contract is completed, we will begin to pre-visualize and plan your engagement session. We will collaborate to choose a location either based on meaning or aesthetic. I will help guide you through your decisions from everything down to potential props and attire. When the day of the session comes, the real fun begins! These sessions are sweet and lighthearted, a time for you to look forward to and enjoy celebrating in this sweet season!

The Questionnaire

In order to help me serve you to the best of my ability on your wedding day, I collect all pertinent information from you through my pre-wedding questionnaire about ____ weeks prior to the event. This is where we'll finalize the timeline, vendor contact information, and family formal shot list.

The Wedding Day

After working together for so many months, I arrive on the wedding day ready to serve you with the comfort of a friend. I am intentional about my demeanor in an effort to make you and your family comfortable on a day that is so important and filled with so many emotions. I use a fineart influenced approach with gentle guidance to photograph the day as it naturally unfolds, while guiding you into poses that feel authentic to you as a couple.

Post-Process

After the wedding, you will receive a sneak peek gallery with highlights from the day within the first week of being married. Once the film is delivered from the lab, full collections will be received within one month from the wedding date. Heirloom Albums are the final touchpoint in the process (and my favorite part), and are tangible documentation of the day that started your marriage. Albums are designed collaboratively using your favorite images and are available for purchase up to one year after the wedding.



These books are handcrafted with the finest linen and leather (in a variety of colors) and printed on museum-quality paper, which means they will stand the test of time and not easily weather with age and handling.
