Ceremony pricing

Most common pricing for ceremony music is **\$300-\$350**, but may be higher depending on travel requirements.

Ceremony music includes up to 30 minutes of prelude music, plus processional and recessional music and up to five minutes afterward.

Special selections to be played during the ceremony are usually included.

I provide my own amplification for the ceremony music, which is included in my basic price.

Packages and options

Cocktail music, one hour solo guitar, when included in package with ceremony: **\$100**.

Cocktail music only, one hour solo guitar: **\$250**.

Additional hours, solo guitar: **\$100** per hour.

Microphone: \$50. I can offer a microphone for you to use at the ceremony. It is a wireless mic that can be handheld or placed on a mic stand. I do require electricity to offer this service.

Vocals: \$50. I am frequently asked to sing as well as play during the cocktail hour. I have many years of professional experience as a vocalist and accompanying myself on acoustic guitar. Many clients are now taking advantage of this option for their cocktail/reception music, as it allows me to provide a much broader range of music which can be more contemporary, fun and upbeat. The fee covers the extra equipment and time necessary to set up. If interested, I can provide you a demo and a songlist of what I play in this format.

SPECIAL REQUESTS: I am happy to learn at least one or two songs especially for you at no extra charge. The exact number of songs I can learn with no charge depends on the time required, as well as the difficulty of learning and preparing the music, which I have to evaluate case by case.
