# *A Consultation Experience like none other*

After you receiving your personalized estimate of services, we will schedule your consultation with the Artistic Director and Salon Owner, Lesley, to discuss ideas and details for your special day.

The goal of this conversation is to ease any concerns or worries that you may have regarding the beauty preparations for your wedding.

We want you to walk away from your consultation feeling 100% confident, relaxed and excited! We will go over your style inspiration and if you will need additions like extension for your dream look. Most of the looks found on Pinterest were created using extensions or hair pieces.



# Trial

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We recommend booking your trial no later than 90 days prior to your wedding. This will provide ample time in case you decide you would like to try an additional look option. If you can arrange it, it's beneficial to schedule your trial the same day as your dress fitting. This ensures you can see the full look together before your big day so we can accommodate any changes.



# Wedding Day

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It is helpful to wear a button down shirt or robe to preserve your finished look.  
Relax and enjoy this time with your wedding party and prepare for your big day knowing you are in good hands and we will do everything possible to achieve your dream beauty looks!



# Other Details

Travel fees will be determined based on the location of where services will be provided for the day off.

A deposit will be included in you estimate and is due upon signing your professional service agreement with the salon. The deposit is applied to your final balance owed.

Pinterest is a great tool to share ideas with us! Once you have decided to book with us we will create a secret board on our Pinterest page that you will be added to so that you can add inspiration photos.

We do offer invoicing to have balances paid in full prior to the wedding to alleviate day of stressors.



# *Suggested Preparation Timeline*

## 1 year to 9 months before your wedding

It's never too early to contact a hairstylist to schedule services for your special day.

## 6-9 months before your wedding

Discuss style, color and length goals with your stylist. Create a plan of action or decide if you want extensions. It's good to test out different options so you can make adjustments.

## 3-6 months before your wedding

If your hair is dry or needs a little extra love, we can set you up with a beauty regime and continue up until your wedding day. If you have severely damaged hair consider starting this sooner, rather than later. Ask your stylist about at-home treatments or schedule a series with a relaxing scalp massage.

3-4 weeks before your wedding: schedule a haircut to keep those ends fresh!

## 1-2 weeks before your wedding:

If you have shorter hair and are wearing it down this is when you want to schedule your haircut. This is the ideal time to ensure the style is fresh but not too short. If you color your hair this would be the time to touch up your color.
