

Planning a wedding can be hard. At Paper Phone Calls I try to make the process as easy as possible. I have been doing this now for almost 10 years and have a lot of tips and tricks to help you through the process. I work with a few different paper wholesalers and I pass those savings along to my couples.

At Paper Phone Calls we do not have set "packages" - it is all build your own. You buy what you need! No wedding is too big or too small. There is also no set quantity. If you need 43 invites that is all you pay for. No extra charge for colored envelopes (sometimes they are more fun to get in the mail than boring white ones) or adding photos to save the dates, thank yous, etc. (we just need a photo release). No extra charges for making changes, etc.

I traditionally don't start working with couples earlier than a year before the big day. I normally start working with you much closer to the big day. I have a pretty quick turn around time and enjoy working with multiple couples at once. Each wedding I design is custom. I work with you as a couple to create affordable, one of a kind pieces to make your day extra special.


Some weddings I design everything from the save the dates and invites to the day of details including programs, place cards, table numbers, large signs, seating charts, thank you notes, etc. Some weddings I just do invitations or day of details. I have done some weddings where I just do the programs or can koozie designs. It really is working with you and what your needs are.

The more you buy, the more you save. For example save the dates are 50% off with the purchase of invites. Programs are 25% off with the purchase of invites. There are a lot of different savings options when you choose to design with Paper Phone Calls. Below you will see some different pricing and options available. Possibilities are endless and if you have some ideas for something I don't offer yet we can work together to create it.



Depending on the type of invite you choose everything is included except postage - envelope addressing is available for \$30 for 100 envelopes. For example - the envelope, RSVP card, information card, etc. Postcard RSVP cards are the most popular and are staples with the swivel and all-in-one invitations as those are perforated and your guests just simply rip them off and pop them in the mail. Enveloped RSVP cards are also available as well as the option to do online RSVPing.




Favor tags or bags, misc. small designs, coaster designs, koozie designs, welcome notes, menus, etc. starting at 25¢
