Here is a quick guide to what you can expect to spend based on your needs; Personals (bridal party), ceremony, cocktail hour and reception.

Personals \$600-\$1,200

- Bridal Bouquet
- Bridesmaid Bouquet
- Boutonnieres (Groom, Groomsmen, Fathers, Grandfathers, Ring Bearer, Ushers, Officiant, honor guest)
- Mothers, Grandmothers, and honor guest (corsages; wrist or pin on, nosegay)
- Flower Girl (Petals, floral halo, comb, small bouquet)
- Toss Bouquet

Ceremony \$100-\$500+

- Pew Markers
- Petals
- Arch/Chuppah
- 1-4 Large arrangements

Cocktail Hour \$75-\$200

- Candles
- Budvases
- Small Arrangements

Reception \$1,000-\$3,000+

- Head table
- Bride and Groom Chair detail
- Large "tall" centerpieces
- Low centerpieces
- Candles
- Garland runners
- Cake or dessert decorations

Extra Detail \$100-\$1,000

- Dinner plate detail
- Place card detail
- Guestbook detail
- Entry sign detail
- Bar detail

On average you can expect to spend \$2,000-\$4,000 for a full-service wedding. That includes personals, ceremony, cocktail hour and reception, delivery/set up, tear down, creative admin fee, and taxes. All prices are averages and subject to changed based on floral choices, quantities, and style.
