

ENGAGEMENT

SESSION

IT TURNED OUT TO BE FUN

If you don't normally like being photographed, an engagement shoot is a great way to discover that being the subject can be so much fun! I also really love getting to know you more before your wedding, and you also get an idea of how it will feel having me as your photographer on the day.

TIME TO EXPRESS YOURSELF

Use this time to express your personality as people and most importantly as a couple. Make it fun and casual, and just enjoy some quality time away from wedding planning and the rest of the world.

CHILL AND RELAX

Your engagement session will give you at least 1 hour – to escape & realize you really are getting married and to have some time together. We can venture to a coffee shop, climb rocks and sight see, run through fields--wherever or whatever! At the same time we will take some photos, I'll give you some light direction for the occasional shot, but most of the time I'll just let things happen. It will be lots of love, connection and fun!

Wear something that makes you feel confident and comfortable. You can combine bold colors, patterned fabric with some casual accessories. Feel free to explore and get creative with your wardrobe!



WEDDING DAY

TIMELINE

A wedding is a whirlwind of events, gone in the blink of an eye. There is little more important to a perfectly executed event than an organized timeline. If you are looking to effectively plan out your wedding day with your wedding coordinator or fiance, here's a look at a typical wedding photo timeline from my point of view.

2-3 HOURS BEFORE THE CEREMONY

I'll begin by meeting the bride at her getting ready location. After starting with stylized shots of the dress, i photograph other details, including shoes, flowers, invitations, and jewelry. If you have 2 photographers, we can do the getting ready pictures for the bride and groom at the same time. We will also capture you and your bridesmaids together and the groom with his men.

60-90 MINUTES BEFORE THE CEREMONY

If you decide to have a private moment, i'll do it shortly after you're ready. If you are going with an intimate first look this would be the time to capture it. We may elect to do some group pictures and even family photographs if time allows.

THE CEREMONY

We make sure you and your bridal party are hidden away about 30 minutes before your ceremony begins. This gives you all a chance to hydrate and re-feul and get ready for your I-Do's!

FOLLOWING THE CEREMONY

Congratulations, you are now husband and wife! We know you want to celebrate so we'll be efficient as possible. If we haven't done family portraits yet, we'll do those immediately following the ceremony. Typically with our planning, we'll need only about 10-15 minutes for this. If the schedule is tight, we can also move the greetings with your guest to the reception.

30-45 MINUTES AFTER THE CEREMONY

We want to capture great photographs with your bridal party, but we also know they want to have a good time as well. We'll need about 45 minutes to get great styled and candid shots, and then they can head to the reception. If we have time and the opportunity, we'll also do some portraits of you together.

30-60 MINUTES BEFORE THE DINNER

For weddings during the summer with longer days, there is time to get to your reception early and enjoy time with guests. Even during other seasons, we're able to flex the time for couple's portraits to before or after the dinner. Upon our arrival, we'll focus on reception details and candids of you with your guests.

THE DINNER

There will be the time on your invitation for when your reception will be, but our next milestone for timing will be when the dinner is to be served. This ensures your meals come out fresh and your guests are happy. We want you to relax and savor your food!

FOLLOWING THE DINNER


We will enjoy a fantastic meal, and after dinner we have the option to escape outside for a brief couple's portrait session while your guests finish eating. You can also use this time to greet your guests at their tables.

THE SUNSETS

Perhaps the biggest variable, and arguably the most important with regards to photography, will be the time the sun sets. This is because the hour preceding sunset is the best light of the day. As part of our wedding planning with you, we'll work to create a schedule to ensure you have a smooth schedule and beautiful pictures.

AFTER DINNER

After the portraits are done, the cake is cut, and the toasts are given, we'll photograph the evening's entertainment. This can include traditional first dances, a large party, fireworks, and even a bride and groom send off!





WEDDING DAY

TIPS

Gather all of your details before the day starts so I can photograph them quickly! This makes the getting-ready portion of the day go by much more smoothly, and it allows me to spend more time focusing on the spontaneous moments.

Here is a list to jog some ideas: rings, jewelry, hair pieces, flowers, shoes, socks, cuff links, letters, pictures, gifts, cultural items, invitations, programs, printed pieces, and any unique items you've put thought into!

One of the most important parts of your wedding day is taking the time to make creative portraits of the two of you. Make sure to carve out 30 minutes to an hour for this. We will guide you through everything, but it's important to remember these portraits require patience and tenacity, and occasionally an adventurous endeavor or two.



WHAT MAKES YOUR WORK DIFFERENT FROM OTHER PHOTOGRAPHER'S WORK?

I am a storyteller- so I love to tell a story with my camera. YOUR STORY. Your wedding day will go by so quickly that you won't even know what happened! Making sure I capture your day as it goes is so important to me. Alot of my couples say they love how they can relive their day by going back through their images.

HOW WOULD YOU DESCRIBE YOUR PHOTOGRAPHY STYLE? Candid, film inspired, lifestyle, and moody with a lot of love + connection

HOW MANY PHOTOGRAPHERS WILL BE AT OUR WEDDING?

For my simplistic + modern collections I offer 2 photographers including myself. I know how big and precious this day is and having a second team ensures that every beautiful moment is documented.

DO YOU HAVE A LIST OF PREFERRED VENDORS TO USE?

Yes, I sure do! From wedding coordinators to florists and caterers, to bridal boutiques, to venues, I have worked with some of the best businesses in the surrounding areas and would be happy to share their information with you.

WHAT HAPPENS IF IT RAINS ON THE WEDDING DAY?

This tends to freak couples out, and that is understandable. But I can tell you that you will still get stunning photographs on a rainy day. Cloudy skies provide a beautiful soft box that makes your skin glow and I can place you guys anywhere without worrying about the sun making you squint. I also always bring along several clear umbrellas and towels to keep you dry!

DO YOU TRAVEL FOR WEDDINGS?

Yes! I love going to new places and I would love to be your destination wedding photographer! All that I ask is that you cover our travel expenses (airfare, hotel, etc)

WHAT EQUIPMENT DO YOU USE?

I use professional digital cameras and lenses from Canon. I always bring along 2 cameras-sometimes even 3 and multiple lenses as well as extra memory cards, flashes, batteries, etc. My gear is regularly maintained and updated all to ensure you receive stunning photographs.

WHAT HAPPENS IF YOU ARE SICK OR OTHERWISE UNABLE TO COME TO OUR WEDDING? This is such an important question. I plan to be there regardless, but if I have to step aside I will make sure you have a talented and reliable photographer that will do an amazing job. I only chose photographers that I fully trust both personally and professionally.

HOW LONG SHOULD WE BOOK AHEAD?

It depends. Some book 2 years in advance and others book 6 months in advance. It's definitely up to you. Some dates are more popular than others, so if you have a date in mind let me know and I'll check my calendar!

HOW DO WE RESERVE OUR WEDDING DATE?

A \$500 non-refundable retainer and signed contract is required in order to get your wedding day on the calendar. 60 days prior to your wedding, the remainder of the balance is due.

DO WE NEED TO FEED YOU AT THE RECEPTION?

We would love that and greatly appreciate it! We try not to take photographs while you and your guests are eating. That is a time where you can relax and enjoy yourselves as husband and wife! We make sure to eat in a timely manner so we can get back to work asap! Also, we love cake!

DO YOU HAVE ANY RECOMMENDATIONS FOR LOCATIONS?

Depending on what you are wanting, I can definitely provide some beautiful locations, and research new spots as well!


