Fees for design, professional delivery, set-up and teardown are charged with our full service option. The fees are individually calculated based on the distance of your venue, the number of staff needed, the amount of time we will work on setting up and any special equipment needed. Please keep this in mind when organizing your budget.

What else?

The prices listed are for what we currently offer, yet we are always open to new designs and ideas. We will meet with you or schedule a phone consult for A la carte (one hour) and Full Service (two hours) as a complimentary service. You will then receive a customized proposal and we will go from there!

There is a \$500 non-refundable deposit required to secure the wedding date. This fee will be deducted from your final bill.

Prices vary based on flower choices, design, and season. Our prices reflect paying our employees a living wage and the time and energy involved in growing, tending and harvesting our own plants.

During our growing season, we arrange primarily with seasonal flowers from our farm.

If we need to supplement the order, we will try first to purchase flowers from another local farm.

If the bride requests something out of season, or that is not locally available we can purchase from a floral wholesaler, which may mean they are not organically grown. Fortunately, due to a growing demand for alternatively grown flowers there often are more options and we try our best to purchase from those farms.
