



## Frye Pricing Packages

So you just got engaged, first of all congrats! This is such an exciting time, and you have a lot of fun times ahead of you planning your perfect day. We wish you all the best during this special time!

### Your Big Day

**Prelude:** Depending on your type of ceremony or where you'd like our services, here's a general outline of what ceremony musicians do. Your musicians provide prelude music, aka the background music as your guests come in and take a seat. This is generally timed for about 20-25 minutes before the start time of your ceremony.

**Processional:** When it's time for the processional to begin, we usually communicate with an usher, wedding planner, officiant, or whoever you've selected to get the ball rolling for the ceremony to begin. Depending on your wedding party, we provide a couple of selections of your choice while this happens. One of our specialties is our ability to time out our music so it ends promptly when the party arrives at the altar. We know how important it is to have the music timed promptly to start and end as the action does.

**Ceremony Music:** Many couples choose to have a "special music" selection in the ceremony to break things up and to incorporate a song or two that has special meaning to them. This is entirely optional and we are happy to help you choose a selection if this is something you'd want. Another time during the ceremony where you might use us is during a "unity candle" lighting or a mixing of sand ceremony. This is common for many couples to do and is appropriate to have a little background music as this happens.

**Recessional/Postlude:** The final aspect of our involvement during your ceremony is the music we provide for the wedding party to process out. We also include some background music as the guests are leaving. Our postlude time varies depending on how you decide to

receive your guests, whether that be dismissing by row, or if everyone heads straight to the next space.

**Cocktail Hour:** One of Wes' specialties is playing upbeat background piano music perfect for a cocktail hour. He also loves taking requests, which makes for fun interactions with guests. If a lobby pianist is something you'd be interested in, please communicate that with us and we'd be happy to provide. This does however encumber an extra fee on top of our standard ceremony prices.

### **Pricing:**

**Standard Ceremony**(including prelude, processional, up to 2 ceremony selections, & recessional/postlude): **\$400**

**Rehearsal Attendance:** **\$75**

**Cocktail Hour Pianist:** **\$150**

**Keyboard/Equipment Transportation Fee**(only if the venue does not have a piano and we have to bring our keyboard): **\$50**

**Transportation Fee**(for weddings outside of a 50 mile radius of where we live): 58 cents a mile

**Extra Ceremony Music:** \$25 per selection
