**\$1,000 - \$2,000 (according to wedding size)**

---

- **Full Service Planning:** (All services included in month-of-coordination) Plus, create budget and manage expenses, theme development and design concept, advice and guidance on surrounding events and celebrations, rehearsal dinner, site selection and contract negotiation, and appointment schedules, detailed food and beverage plan, event logistics/venue review, develop and manage production schedule, custom stationery/invitations and welcome booklets with itinerary, activities and local information for guests, monthly forecast and management of checklists, guest accommodations, on-going etiquette advice.

**\$2,500 - \$5,000 (according to wedding size)**
