

Rev Kris Miller Ceremony Options and fees (*Fees listed are for Monroe County. If your ceremony will be located outside of Monroe County, please let me know the location and I can quote you a fee.*)

Custom Created Ceremony: This is the most popular option. You make selections for every part of the ceremony from my website to create a ceremony that expresses your thoughts on love and relationship and share highlights of your story as a couple. I will ensure that transitions are written so it flows smoothly. You can write your own vows or choose some that are already written. I have a wide variety of unity ceremony options to choose from and also welcome new ideas. You can create a ceremony that is about love and relationship (secular) or one that includes God or other spiritual beliefs.

Elegantly Easy Ceremony: Choose from several prewritten ceremonies (secular or with prayers and spiritual blessings). Add your vows of your choice (or write your own) and a unity ceremony if you choose. The rest is already done!

Marriage Handfasting: Choose from two prewritten ceremonies or create your own.

My fees for Custom Created Ceremonies, Elegantly Easy Ceremonies and Marriage Handfastings are determined by distance. In Monroe County the fees are \$300 without rehearsal/ \$400 with rehearsal. These fees include:

- Initial Consultation Meeting
- Ceremony customization and personalization
- Rehearsal (if requested-see fee schedule above.)
- Travel to ceremony site
- Coordinating with all your vendors the day of the ceremony
- Completing and filing the NYS license you obtained from the clerk

Short and Sweet Ceremonies are perfect for intimate gatherings and elopements. These ceremonies are available for booking only on short notice (within 2 months of the ceremony date). There are 13 options to choose from, and you can select/write your own vows. Rehearsals are not available. My fees for Short and Sweet Ceremonies are \$150 in Monroe County and include:

- Communication and ceremony selection via email or phone
- Travel to ceremony site
- Coordinating with all your vendors the day of the ceremony
- Completing and filing the NYS license you obtained from the clerk

For all options a signed agreement and deposit of one half the fee is required.
