<u>First Steps</u>

Once you have decided to reach out, I send a questionnaire to gather more information. We then set up either a coffee date, zoom meeting or phone call to see if we are a good fit. I try to answer any questions you have at this stage. Please feel free to ask me anything!

You've decided to book me for your day!

Once we have decided to lock it down I then send you an electronic contract as well as an invoice for retainer. The contract is very user friendly. You sign and submit, it sends it to me, I sign, then it sends a completed version so you can download and print or store on your computer in pdf form. The invoice is also electronic and you can pay it with a credit or debit card at no extra charge. I take a \$1000 retainer or if you choose to pay in full I offer a 10% discount as long as you aren't booking within 30 days of your date.

I do offer payment plans, complete payment is due 30 days before your wedding date. Once all the admin work is finished we can get to the fun details!

Timeline and shot lists

Around 3-4 months before the big day, I send a very detailed questionnaire to start putting together timelines and shot lists. If you have a planner, we can set up a phone date and coordinate. The more information we have the better we can plan and be able to deal with any unexpected issues on your day. For me, planning keeps you in the moment and able to enjoy all the festivities.

THINGS TO CONSIDER

The most important thing to think about when choosing your outfits is do they look like you, and are they comfortable? If you aren't comfortable, it will show.

I love the 2 outfit combo, one causal and the other a bit more dressy. Engagement photos are great for showing your personality as a couple leading up to your wedding day. If there is a special place that means something to you, maybe where you got engaged, feel free to share. If there is a special date night ritual that we can document, I love that too!

I would want to see your outfit selections before the shoot so we can talk about locations and I can match color schemes and vibe.

Pinterest boards are encouraged! I'm obviously a visual person, so show me examples.

WEDDING day tips



Take it all in

You have spent so much time and energy on all the details leading up to the day. I encourage you to really allow yourself to enjoy it.

Don't give yourself too much to do the day of besides show up!

Have a box ready to go for flat lays and detail shots. While you are getting ready, I can get those! This can include jewelry, perfume, cologne, garter, tie, vow books, shoes, invitations, rsvp, save the dates, ring boxes, and of course rings.

If you are including any family heirlooms or anything sentimental just let me know. I want to make sure I include those.

I do another flat lay usually sometime during the reception with flowers and other details. Have matching hangers for the wedding party. They look much better than plastic ones. Bring a steamer just in case you need to touch up.

If we are walking around a bit for photos, make sure you have a pair of slip on shoes you can easily get on and off.

If I have seen any one area slow down an itinerary, it's hair and makeup. Take into account how many people need services and make sure you hire a team that can handle your wedding party.

From a Photographer's Perspective

This day belongs to you and your partner. There will be lots of people wanting your attention, and it will go by in a flash. Make a list of must have shots, to make sure we have carved out enough time for just your couple's portraits. I see so many couples get rushed when it's time for just them because they have tried to make sure everyone is included in pictures. They also get rushed because they don't want their guests to wait too long. I will, also, initiate a couple's portrait session right at sunset for about 10 minutes. This time with my couples always proves to be my favorite!







I truly believe you and your partner should do what makes your heart happy, and leaves you with no regrets when you look back on your day.

There are advantages and disadvantages to both. If you do a first look, you get to spend more of your day with your partner. It can be just as intimate and you don't have everyone watching you as you see each other for the first time. It's also a great way to get those wedding day jitters worked out in private.

I usually photograph for about 3-5 minutes then I give you 5-10 mins alone. This will likely be the last time you are alone for the rest of the day.

If you have always dreamed of seeing your partner for the first time walking down the aisle, it will no doubt be a moment you both won't forget. I truly feel you should be at ease either way.




Things to keep in mind


It's important to consider the time of year you are getting married. How much daylight will you have? How much time do you want your guests to wait after the ceremony? How extensive is your shot list and family portraits? How much time would like you to spend on just couples photos?



DO YOU SHARE A SNEAK PEAK?






