- I am not a wedding planner, but when it comes to the big day, I am 100% prepared to take charge and make sure everything happens and on schedule.

If it's not obvious already, I will do almost anything to make sure that your day is absolutely perfect. I am here to help you. My brides are welcome to call me in the middle of the night if they've been drinking too much wine and are starting to get nervous about the wedding. I will walk you through everything at the same time as calming your nerves.

the process

HOW IT WORKS

- 1 You contact me saying that you want to book and which package, and ask any questions you have
- 2 You fill out the "about my wedding" form so I can get familiar with your vision and plans
- 3 I send you your contract
- 4 You sign the contract and pay your deposit
- 5 You get my phone number and we can text/call about whatever you want. Scared? Unsure about a certain detail? Need an artistic eye? I'm just a quick message away
- 6 About 2 months away from the wedding, we meet in person over a coffee or over Skype to discuss essential topics about your wedding day, and make sure we're on the same page. We create a shot list together
- 7 A lot of brides choose to do their separate bridal session 3-7 days before their wedding.
- 8 The big day!
- 9 The next day, you'll get a sneak peek of some images from me. Hopefully you have a chance to look at them while you're at the airport on the way to your honeymoon!
- 10 You will receive your online gallery within 45 days of your wedding. Your thumb drive will also be mailed out within 45 days.

And there you have it! Best friends for life. We stalk each other on social media every once in a while. I take your one year anniversary photos... then the photos of your first baby... then your first family photos.... oh, what life has in store!!!



frequently asked questions

Do you charge a travel fee?

Yes. I charge travel fees for any wedding that happens more than 1.5 hours outside of San Diego or LA. I try to work with all of my couples so that you're only paying exactly what it costs for me to travel. It will all be laid out clearly in our contract. I will charge gas money for a wedding that I can drive to. If your wedding is more than 2 hours away from San Diego and I will need to stay the night, I will charge for that. You have the option of booking my travel yourself (flights, hotels, airbnbs, etc.). When I book travel for myself, I will try to fly the most economical way and book the most reasonably inexpensive airbnb. I want you to be able to put as many of those dollars towards the honeymoon as you can!

Do you offer Videography?

I don't do video! Although I think it's an essential part of capturing your wedding day, it's not something I offer at this point in time. If you want, I can point you in the direction of several videographers in the area that I think would do a wonderful job for you!

What are my pay-schedule options?

For every wedding package, I ask for a deposit of half of your total upfront. This is non-refundable (although it is transferable if plans change). The rest of the cost after that is able to be split up and paid on whatever timetable you choose, as long as it is all paid prior to your wedding day!

How long will my wedding be backed up for?

Forever! Although the images won't be on the online delivery service for more than several months, I backup every single edited image for every single client of mine on several different systems. I will never delete your images and if something happens to your copies - you will always be able to contact me and get those treasures back!

If I do a separate bridals session, will I be able to get images back in time to print and display at our reception?

Absolutely. One of my favorite decorations at my wedding was a canvas of our bridal shoot that we had done a week prior. If you choose to do a bridals session 2+ days before the wedding, I will guarantee getting at least 3-4 edited images back to you in time to print for decoration!

How should I get details of the day to you?

I would love to get a schedule of your wedding day as soon as you have it! I will meet with you in person or via Skype around 2 months before your wedding. At that time we'll go through the names of your VIP's (immediate family & bridal party) so I know who everyone is and we'll discuss any sensitive subjects (like divorced parents) so that no one feels uncomfortable on the wedding day. We'll put together a family formals shot list and most importantly finalize your timeline with any last minute planning changes and make sure we are on the same page!



Why is having a 2nd photographer important?

With 2 shooters, one person can focus on getting the “safe and necessary shots” - like the bride coming down the aisle with her dad. Whereas the 2nd photographer can be getting the more creative image or more “risky shots” like mom tearing up as she watches her daughter coming down the aisle or the groom’s reaction. The 2nd shooter will also be starting with the guys during groom prep where as I will be with the bride and her girls!

How would you describe your working style on the wedding day?

I am most often a fly on the wall. Doing so helps me to capture what is happening in a super natural way. On the flip side, I’m also going to take the reins when it’s appropriate (like during, family portraits) I’m not afraid to politely yet assertively help move things along and say “Ok Smith family! We are going to be starting family photos! If you’re a Smith come on down!”



Will I get the images in Black & White?

Black and white is one of my favorite ways to edit wedding photos. Though I won’t be giving every photo back to you in b&w, I will include b&w copies of many of the images. Typically, if I send you a b&w version of an image, I will also send the color copy (unless the colors were distorted by the lighting and it just looks better in b&w).

What happens if you can’t come to our wedding for some reason?

I will try my hardest to be at your wedding no matter what. But in the case of natural disaster, death, etc. I will find a photographer that I know and trust to come take care of you. If I can be there but can’t take the photos (i.e. broken arm), I will bring that photographer but will still be there to help things move smoothly as we’d have previously discussed.

MAKE SURE YOU LIKE YOUR WEDDING PHOTOGRAPHER!

You'll be spending a lot of time with your photographer on one of the biggest days of your life, it's important to be sure they are a good fit. Ask yourself... Are our personalities a good match? (Following them on social media is a great way to find out!) Would I want to be friends with this person outside of a business relationship? Am I comfortable with this person's work and communication style? Has this photographer listened well and addressed all my concerns?
