Q: How far in advance should I book my service?

Savannah is one of the most desired destination wedding locations in America today. Old Savannah Tours is the most called upon local Tour and Transportation Company, six months to a year is often preferred. The busiest times for Savannah Weddings are September thru December, and then February through June. While we try to accommodate all requests, it is not always possible, but we are always here to help!

Q: What vehicles do you feature, and what color are they?

Old Savannah Tours features white 35- passenger open-aired trolleys or 32-passenger air-conditioned minibuses to transport your guests.

Q: What are your rates?

You can rent either vehicle at the rate of \$525.00 for the first 3 hours, and then \$150.00 for each additional hour.

A 50% deposit is due at the time of signing; the remaining balance is due one week prior to service. If you wish to add a gratuity, we will be happy to do so.

Q: Is alcohol permissible on the vehicles?

Yes, however all containers must be plastic or aluminum.

Glass bottles are not allowed according to our local laws and the Department of Transportation.
