

Two Weeks Before

~ do a run through of your hair and make up with your stylist and make-up artist, so you and they know what to expect and can get it right on your "Big Day" Make sure you have the same colors in your emergency kit.

~try on your dress a few days before your wedding just to make sure all is good with the fit.

~ don't tan or spray tan the day before or even the week of your wedding, you might not like what you get color-wise and tans don't always come across well in photographs.

~If you are going to have a facial done, make sure to have it done a week before so if you have a break-out your skin has time to repair itself.

~Clean your rings and all of the jewelry you will wear on your wedding day. SPARKLES please!

~If your gown is strapless, take your bra off three hours before you have photos taken. This way the strap marks do not show up in photos.

Bag of Tricks for your Wedding
Day

Don't forget about the things you may need the day of your Wedding. Have an emergency bag filled with things you may need throughout the day and make sure to grab it or have someone grab it on the way out the door.

Makeup

A great way to have everything you need but in just the right amount is when you're purchasing your makeup, ask your sales person for samples of everything that you buy. Compact and won't take up much room, but there when you need it.





Emergency Bag must-have's:

Water **Hairspray Perfume** Travel sewing kit Safety pins Earring backs **Emery board & nail polish Drinking Straw** Deoterant Baby wipes Panty hose Throat Lozenges Aspirin/lbuprofin Breath mints/gum **Tissues** Hand cream - non greasy **Band aids** Antacid **Tampons** Tide Stick/shout wipes

Cash:

Stash some cash in your bag for any little thing that might come up.

Shoes:

Remember you are going to be on your feet most of the day. Make sure to wear your shoes ahead of time to break them in. If you think they may be a problem, bring a more comfortable pair to change into when you need them. Depending on where you are having your photographs done, grass and fields can ruin your gorgeous shoes. Be sure to have a pair of flats you can slip on.

TIP: fill an
elongated balloon
with water.
Place the balloon
inside your shoe &
put both items
in the freezer.

Food:



Stash an emergency power bar or two in your kit.

Lots of stress during the day and a lot of brides don't eat much, so a back-up nutritional bar is great! Also, have some food

at your hotel in case you're starving after you get back from the festivities.

Itinerary:

Have an itinerary on hand and a point person to keep things on track. Make copies and give them to family and a few good friends. Choose a point person. Things will go a lot more smoothly. I have equiped you with all my wedding day knowledge. It's now up to you to plan one heck of a party!



Get Prepared for {Bridal} Shows

GIPS

Shows are a great way to sample catering and see floral arrangements, but they can make for a long day and information overload if you are not prepared

Preregister if the show offers that option.

Shows may have entrance lines. and preregistering emliminates the need to fill out paperwork while a plethora of other brides are doing so.

Create Labels

Be sure to include your name, address, email, phone number and wedding date. This will save you time and keep your hand from hurting.

Keep your purse light

Normally you will receive a bridal bag. If not you may want to bring an extra empty tote for collecting information. Save your shoulder and only bring the essentials.

Have a friend tag along {but not an entourage!}

Having key people come with you is a lifesaver. They can help you with ideas and gracefully guide your timetable with vendors. Be careful not to bring too many as trying to move through with a group of ten can be difficult.

Bring Water.

Most bridal shows are very heavy on the food, yet beverages are scarce. Bring water or at least scope out the water fountains so you can stay hydrated.

Go hungry {but bring snacks}

Shows have caterers and cake artists who are waiting to tempt your tastebuds. Go with an appetite. If there are less sampling stations than expected, a snack with offer sustenance.

Have an open mind

Services that may not top your list could make your life easier {or wedding more fun!} in the end. Look for trends, color combinations, unique flowers, and other things you can view in person rather than in a magazine. You may leave with a few new ideas

Bring a manilla envelope

Placing information from vendors you are serious about in a separate envelope will ensure that the florist that impressed you isn't forgotten about in the shuffle of papers you take home.

Take information, and regroup at home.

Collect information for the vendors that interest you. Once home, you can spread out the paperwork and sort through it

Be prepared for emails and follow ups.

Expect for vendors to follow up with you after the show via email or even a phone call if you expressed that you were interested in their services.
