The gorgeous building also houses a restaurant, bar and large patio that combine the warmth of original wood detailing with modern touches and a vibrant social scene. Located in the heart of San Francisco's dynamic Valencia corridor at 777 Valencia in the Mission District.

Event Space Descriptions

The Chapel:

Seats up to 150 guests for dining and can accommodate up to 400+ guests reception style on the main floor, with additional space provided by the beautiful mezzanine and balcony that overlook the main room. The historic chapel combines sophisticated charm and cutting edge equipment to satisfy each event request. The Chapel was recently rated as one of the most beautiful music venues in California and includes two private bars, stage, private dressing rooms, and professional sound, lighting and video systems.



The Chapel Mezzanine:

Available as a separate rental from the main floor of The Chapel, the mezzanine accommodates up to 100 guests reception style, or can be set up as a seated event for social mixers or private parties. The Chapel Mezzanine can be also reserved as a VIP buyout during regular musical shows with advance notice, and its position overlooking the main hall and stage provides preferred vantage points for performances. Private balcony, bar and restroom all included.

The Restaurant:

The charming restaurant space is accented with wood and stained glass trim, granite bar, and gorgeous chandeliers, and can accommodate 85 guests seated, or up to 120 guests reception style. A semi-private dining space seats 20 and can be combined with show tickets for a complete evening out. Advanced notice required.



Outdoor Patio:

Patio with stucco walls, custom ironwork railing, and nighttime lighting seats 70, or reception style holds 120+. Can be set up with a private bar. The patio can be combined with restaurant or Chapel rentals to allow for outdoor receptions for private events

The Main Bar:

Seats up to 85 guests and can accommodate up to 120 guests reception style. With a warm and inviting interior, the fully equipped, large private bar provides the perfect arena for any occasion. Communal seating allows for larger groups to relax and enjoy themselves in a comfortable and cohesive setting. Includes state-of-the-art sound system for DJ or small band performances, as well as TV monitors with Direct TV and DVD capabilities.



Event Space Minimums

The Chapel and Mezzanine:

Thursday-Saturday Fee:

\$7,500.00 Rental and \$9,000.00 Food/Beverage minimum for a total of \$16,500.00++

Sunday-Wednesday Fee:

\$6,000.00 Rental and \$6,000.00 Food/Beverage minimum: for a total of \$12,000.00 ++

++ Indicates that 20 % taxable Service Charge, Sales Tax of 8.75% and 3% SF Mandate are not included on Food and Beverage Minimum. We also require a Certificate of Insurance.

Can be combined with the Main Bar to increase capacity by 120+.

The Mezzanine only:

Rental Fee: \$1,000.00 and \$1,500.00 Food/Beverage minimum: for a total of \$2,500. ++

++ Indicates that 20 % taxable Service Charge, Sales Tax of 8.75% and 3% SF Mandate are not included on Food and Beverage Minimum. We also require a Certificate of Insurance.

VIP Booth in the Mezzanine: Available during scheduled shows as a VIP buyout with cocktail service. Exclusive area separated from other customers on the mezzanine with decorative iron railing and velvet rope, offering booth plus additional seating to accommodate 12 guests. Advanced notice required.

Beverage minimum: \$400 plus cost of show tickets (20 % taxable Service Charge, Sales Tax of 8.75% and 3% SF Mandate not included on Food and Beverage Minimum).

The Restaurant:

Food and Beverage minimum: \$8,000.00 (can include the patio)

20% taxable Service Charge, Sales Tax of 8.75% and 3% SF Mandate not included on Food and Beverage Minimum.

The Main Bar:

Seasonal Food Menus And Pricing Are Available Upon Request.

The Chapel enjoys the services of an on-site full service restaurant, which provides exclusive catering for all events. Executive Chef Elaine Osuna of acclaimed sister restaurants A Cote and Rumbo al Sur in Oakland oversees menu creation and execution. Available offerings include light and heavy appetizers; meals served buffet style, and sit-down dinners with a focus on seasonal, local and sustainable ingredients. Brunch menu packages are also available for groups.

- Pricing available for champagnes, specialty drinks and dinner wine service. Wine or Liquor requests will be accommodated based on availability.

Reservations & Conditions:

To confirm a reservation we require a 50% deposit on the rental fee and Food and Beverage Minimum and a signed contract. The deposit will be deducted from the total bill at the time of the settlement. The final balance of the payment is due three business days prior to the event. Final guest count and menu selection is required 1 week in advance of the event. No outside food or beverage is allowed.

Parking: There is no parking provided onsite. There is some street parking available, with meter enforcement ending at 6:00 pm.
