How do I book my wedding photography?

Below are my wedding collections. Once you find a collection that works for you, click select and scroll to the bottom. Click Continue to take you to the contract section, you can fill that out with your wedding date and any details that you already have. If you don't have all of those details, that is ok. Just insert TBD and go on to the next. Once you both sign the contract, you will be taken to the invoice page. I do require a \$500 non-refundable deposit to secure your wedding date.

Once the deposit and contract are complete, you are officially booked! From there, we start to plan your engagement session and I am happy to answer all sorts of wedding questions you may have. About a month from the wedding I will begin working on a customized wedding day timeline to work with your day-of events. This helps me and my team to stay on time and keep things moving throughout the day.

What to expect:

After your booking is complete you are officially a Lea Marie Bride! Yay!

You and I will work together to customize your experience. You can reach out to me anytime with any questions about your wedding. I love weddings and all things that encompasses!

When you're ready to plan your engagement session, we can chat about locations and options for your session. I want you to feel comfortable and relaxed so that your natural selves come through in the photos. If you have questions about what to wear, just ask. I am so happy to help. It's always nice to have a casual outfit as well as something a bit more dressy for your photos.

A month from your wedding I will send you a questionnaire asking about the events of the day and the type of photos you'd like to have. This helps me put together a strong timeline that we will use to keep everyone on time and ensure that we don't miss any important moments. I also ask that you send me a copy of your invitation suite about a month before the wedding, I like to photograph this without any time constraints before your wedding, just in case we run short on time.

Two weeks before your wedding, we can discuss the timeline and any other last minute questions you might have and finalize your family formal list. This is a great time to mention any moments that you are really looking forward to having captured.

On the wedding day, I will arrive to meet the Bride and my second shooter will join the Groom and his Groomsmen. I will capture the Bride with her Bridesmaids getting ready in the Bridal suite. This is when I will need all of your details. (dress, jewelry,

shoes, bouquet, garter, veil, etc) This will make the detail shots more efficient! The same goes for the Grooms items. Have those ready for the second shooter. They will get detail images of those things as well.

If you choose to have a first look, I ask that you try to keep this as intimate as possible. This means, just the two of you. Of course we will be there to capture it, but we want genuine emotion which is sometimes hard to get with a group of people watching.

Please don't forget to give me any specific instructions for the ceremony location. A lot of churches have rules for photographers, and we want to make sure to stay within the guidelines set.

Family formals usually come immediately after the ceremony. Please make sure any quests you would like in these photos are notified beforehand so that they stay in the area after the processional. This will keep us on time and make sure we get grandparents off their feet sooner.

We usually wrap up about an hour after the dancefloor opens. We will be sure to pop by and say goodnight before we leave. Please let us know if there is anything else we can do at this point!
