Your wedding is important

Wedding planning can seem overwhelming. You want everything to go smoothly on that day.

I am committed to providing you value with quality images and professional service, as well as the peace of mind that your wedding photography will be taken care of.

There are two things that are included with any of my collections.

Digital Images. Your edited images will be available for you in a private on-line gallery. From the gallery, you can view them, download them with a print release, and purchase prints and wall art. Even better, anyone with whom you share the link to the gallery can do the same – this is handy if you have friends and family who are unable to come to your wedding. I provide these because that candid image at your ceremony is something that becomes even more precious with the passage of time. These are your memories and you should be able to access them when you want.

Album. I believe in print. A picture posted on social media gets forgotten after a while, hard drives crash, and your cell phone can die. A professionally printed album, however, can last for generations. It is your first family heirloom.

For my top two collections, I use Graphistudio, located in Italy. Graphistudio offers a large variety of material, state of the art printing, and the ability to print custom designs. This means your wedding album will be unique for you and not look the same as for thousands of other couples.

Prices include planning consultations, travel within 115 miles of Knoxville for the engagement sessions and wedding, venue visit/walkthrough, album design and printing, and sales tax.

What Does Coverage Mean?

Coverage is the time you expect the photographer to be on-site for you, whether it is getting ready at a hotel before the ceremony or at the reception site.

So, if your ceremony starts at 4:00 pm, and you plan to have a cocktail hour followed by a reception ending at 9:00 pm, and all you want are pictures of the ceremony, family pictures during the cocktail hour, and then photos during the reception, you would need five hours of coverage.

But let's say you plan to arrive at the ceremony site at 1:00 pm to start getting ready and you want pictures of that, as well as a "reveal" of you in your dress to your parents, plus other pre-ceremony pictures. Then you need eight hours of coverage.

Other factors can come into play, such as travel time between the hotel where you are getting ready, the church, and the reception. That is why it is important for us to meet to talk about what is important to you.





Engagement Sessions

Engagement sessions serve a valuable purpose. They allow us to get to know one another, they let you get comfortable in front of a camera, and they provide you with pictures of you both that are not “dated” as obviously being taken your wedding date. It is nice to be able to display images of the two of you in a more casual setting. Plus, the pictures can be used for Save the Date or Thank You cards, or in a guest book for people to sign at your wedding.


I ask you to plan at least two hours for your engagement session, more if we have to travel between locations. I recommend you bring a change of clothing, so you can have both “casual” and “dressy” pictures.

Are you nervous about getting “good” pictures? The engagement session is your warm up so that on your wedding day you are more relaxed when you are having your picture taken. And that means great photos!

LET'S GET STARTED

What are the next steps?

1. In-person meeting or telephone/Skype call to verify all the terms and costs.
2. You both sign the contract and pay a non-refundable retainer of 30% of the price.
3. I then will reserve your wedding date. That means I will accept no other weddings on that date; you are my sole client.
4. We start planning your engagement session. As we get closer to your wedding date, we will also be drafting a timeline for your wedding day.



Behind the scenes, I am preparing by scouting your venue, checking to see if there are restrictions for photography at your church, coordinating with your wedding planner, etc. My goal is that on your wedding day, photography is the least of your worries and unexpected issues such as bad weather or a change of schedule can be handled without compromise to your pictures.
