FAQ

How much time should I allow for our first look and wedding portraits?

If you are running a tight ship, 30 minutes will cover it just fine. If you would like to explore the area around your venue a bit more and get a wider selection of couple shots, we could easily fill an hour!

For that matter, what the heck is a first look and do I need one?

Yes, you want to do this. Enough said. Ok but seriously, this will be the one time in the day that is JUST the two of you. The idea that the couple should not see each other before the ceremony is kind of silly, and originally stemmed from arranged marriages. The first moment you see each other on your wedding day will be so precious, and just for the two of you.

How much time should I allow for family and wedding party photos?

A bare minimum of 30 minutes, but try to budget 3-5 minutes per grouping of people you would like. The actual shooting will be relatively quick, but sometimes wrangling people takes time! I would also recommend having a point person to do the wrangling that is NOT you.

How long will it take for me to get my photos?

You will have your digital images in 2-4 weeks! If you are ordering an album or prints, we will meet so you can choose your favorite images, then the products will be on your doorstep in 2-3 more weeks.

Should I buy prints?

Before you make any print purchases, think about what you want to use them for. Small wallet prints? Large prints for the wall? Small prints can be purchased for much cheaper at a drug store, as quality is not as important. I do recommend purchasing any large or mounted prints through the online gallery I provide, as they are archival and will last forever!

Will the images I get be edited?

Absolutely! I lovingly retouch every single image I give you. This does not mean adding crazy Instagram filters or airbrushing you to look like a magazine add, this means carefully going over each image to transform it from good to great! You and yours will look your natural best.

Do you travel for weddings?

Hell yeah! I will gladly follow you wherever you want to go. Passport ready and waiting! You cover airfare and accommodations, and all the other prices stay the same. My regular coverage means I will follow you anywhere in Washington State, by the way.

Do you do engagement shoots a-la-carte?
