



# Weddings at House on Metolius

A pristine landscape on the banks of the crystal-clear Metolius River with a panoramic backdrop of Mt. Jefferson and Three Fingered Jack, on two-hundred acres of private property surrounded by national forest—this is your wedding setting.

House on Metolius has served as a private estate and retreat for over a hundred years. The property now hosts a small number of exclusive weddings each year, and our staff is dedicated to creating the experience of your dreams. Our outdoor weddings take advantage of the stunning private landscape to provide a memorable backdrop for the ceremony itself and the subsequent reception.

The wedding package includes exclusive use of the Main House, including its facilities and accommodations. Accommodations in the Main House include seven bedrooms and one bridal suite, in addition to the great room, dining room, and kitchen spaces.

Reception dinners generally take place on the patio adjoining the Main House on the west side—this is the perfect location for wedding guests to enjoy dining and dancing into the evening. The patio seats up to 180 people and is located on a bluff overlooking the Metolius River, with views of Three-Finger Jack and Mount Jefferson.

If you have not had an opportunity to visit us before, please inquire about making a site visit. We will credit your over-night accommodation towards the wedding package when you book.

## Frequently Asked Questions

### ***Where is House on Metolius located?***



House on Metolius is located about 2.5 hours by car from Portland, Oregon, in the Cascade Mountains. The nearest airport is Redmond, Oregon, approximately 45 minutes away.

### ***What is your capacity for the wedding celebration?***

For outdoor weddings, House on Metolius can accommodate 180 wedding guests. The capacity for an indoor wedding is 40 people.

### ***How many people can you accommodate as overnight guests?***

The Main House is included in the wedding package and includes eight bedrooms for a total of 16 people. There are also six cabins on the property, accommodating between 2 and 6 people each, for a total of 22 guests. Total sleeping accommodations on the property are 38 people.

### ***What is the overall size of the House on Metolius property?***

The property itself is over 210-acres; the Metolius River flows through the middle of the property.

***For those guests not staying at House on Metolius, what other accommodations are available in the surrounding area?***

There are several other resorts and numerous private cabins available for rent in the Camp Sherman area, most of which are no more than 10-15 minutes away from the property. Black Butte Ranch and Sisters also have several hotels and many private rental options, and are 15 to 25 minutes away.

***What are the options for dining and catering?***

House on Metolius has a flexible policy with regard to catering; we work with a number of catering companies. We do require that you use professional catering services and will coordinate with your caterer well in advance of the event to make sure that everything is in place.

***What are the arrangements and policies related to alcohol?***

There are no corkage fees and you are free to provide your own alcohol. However, as required by law and per our insurance arrangements, we do absolutely require that you have a licensed bartender to serve the drinks at your wedding. We can arrange to chill your alcohol in advance of the event.

For reasons of licensing and insurance, we require a photocopy of licenses and servers' OLLC cards before alcohol can be served. Please have the provider bring these with them.

***What equipment and services are available?***

Most of our weddings take advantage of our Seating and Equipment Package, which includes dining tables and chairs, serving tables and a variety of other equipment for outdoor seating. More information about our packages can be found in the Additional Packages and Services document.

***What are the parking arrangements for the wedding?***

House on Metolius has ample parking for your guests. Our staff will direct guests during the parking process.

***Is there somewhere on the property to arrange flower arrangements and other wedding features prior to the event?***

At your request, we can put our maintenance shop and a number of large tables at your disposal for flower arrangements.

House on Metolius staff will assist in moving your flowers to the patio or porch area, or to the meadow wedding site.

***Should we use a wedding coordinator?***

Our customers have found professional wedding coordination to be an invaluable part of their event experience. House on Metolius requires that you contract with a professional wedding coordinator or day-of coordinator for your event. For your convenience, we can provide a list of recommended providers.

***Are the services of the House on Metolius staff included in the package?***

House on Metolius staff will set up items from our equipment package and move them to accommodate your ceremony and reception setting. HoM staff will light and keep the fires going as best we can. Our staff will light all patio heaters, if needed, and make sure they stay lit during your event.

If you require additional services please let us know and we can make the necessary arrangements.

***What is the weather like and do we need to make arrangements for rainy weather?***

While Central Oregon enjoys clear skies throughout the year, we do encourage our guests to consider arrangements, such as tents, for unexpected weather during the festivities. Since the specific requirements will depend on the time of year, the number of guests and your event setup, we look forward to discussing this in more detail with you.

***What activities can we arrange in the days before and after the wedding?***

Many wedding parties choose to extend their stay by a few days either before or after the wedding. There are many activities both on and off the property to entertain family and friends. Here at House on Metolius, our guests may enjoy fly fishing, croquet, badminton, volleyball or walks along the river and in the surrounding forest. We are also very close to excellent facilities for golf and horseback riding. Central Oregon's natural environment is justly famous, and there are numerous hiking, rafting, kayaking, and rock climbing options. Finally, Sisters and Bend offer enjoyable shopping, dining and beer or wine tasting locations.

The wedding package includes two nights in the Main House and exclusive use of the wedding site during that time for up to forty wedding guests. The charge for additional guests is \$50 per person. There are six cabins that are also available for rental; pricing varies by season.
