## Saint Lucia's Premier Historic Site

With beautiful well-maintained lawns, century old trees and mysterious ruins, Pigeon Island National Landmark is an unmatched venue with magnificent scenery on which to document another important occasion - **Your Dream Wedding!**

For the perfect wedding, one can choose from a variety of locations: The Gazebo, Private Beaches, Cliff-side (old Jazz Lawn) and for the adventurous - Fort Rodney. In this idyllic setting, the wedding will be given the significance it deserves.

## Rich History

Pigeon Island is one of the Caribbean's most historic landmarks and certainly one of the most beautiful spots in Saint Lucia. While Pigeon Island's rich history dates back to pre-Columbian times, it is most famous for its role in the 1782 Battle of the Saints. For it was from Pigeon Island that Admiral Rodney monitored Fort Royal in Martinique and set sail to intercept the French troops, fortuitously preventing their rendezvous with the Spanish and saving Jamaica for the British Empire.

## Stunning Vistas

Pigeon Island National Landmark is more than historic ruins and abandoned forts. It is also white sand beaches, expansive lawns interspersed with towering coconut trees, beautiful old-growth flowering trees, dramatic coastlines, and several species of tropical fauna including the elusive mongoose and the kestrel.

The 44 acre reserve was once completely surrounded by the Caribbean Sea, but was joined to the mainland by a causeway in 1972 making access a lot easier.



# Getting Married in *Saint Lucia*

Saint Lucia's dramatic landscapes and natural beauty create an aura of romance, leaving small wonder as to why the island has been named "World's Leading Honeymoon Destination" a total of eight times starting in 2002.

Whether one prefers a sunset wedding on the beach or a more formal affair, Saint Lucia has the ideal setting for your special day.

To get married in Saint Lucia, an **Application for Marriage** must be made to the Attorney General of Saint Lucia after two days on the Island.

The following original documents are to be produced:

- Birth Certificate
- Passport
- Divorce decree absolute (if divorced)
- Death certificate of former spouse (if widowed)
- Deed poll in case of name change (if name has been changed)
- Authentic translation for any documents not in English.

If under 18, evidence of consent in the form of an affidavit stamped by the Notary Royal is required.
