- \$300 for a simple/romantic ceremony
- \$475 for a personalized ceremony
- \$100 for a rehearsal (if applicable)
- \$100+ for travel over 20 miles outside of 93117 zip code

Simple/Romantic Ceremony (\$300)

This ceremony, centered on love, includes the standard elements of a classic wedding. Couple can choose to write their own vows, add readings, include rituals, or otherwise shape the ceremony as they like. I have nonreligious and Christian versions of this ceremony available, plus a variety of possible vows, readings, etc.

Personalized Ceremony (\$475)

This ceremony is highly personalized, including a couple's "love story" of how they met, fell in love, and decided to marry. It may also include expanded interfaith or multicultural traditions, more complex rituals (such as handfasting), bilingual passages, and additional elements. Please contact me to learn more.

Rehearsal (\$100) (if applicable)

Ceremonies that include wedding rituals or multiple speakers would benefit from a rehearsal with me. I can attend a rehearsal to help coordinate the bridal (wedding) party or for any other reason you might want me there. I help coordinate the order of the ceremony, where people should stand, processional/recessional, etc. If you think you'd like me at your rehearsal, be sure to let me know as soon as possible so that I can reserve the date for you. I charge \$100 for a rehearsal.

Travel Fee (\$100+) (if applicable)

My rate includes travel within 20 miles of zip code 93117 to the ceremony location. For travel beyond 20 miles, I contract with the couple for an agreed-upon fee depending on the distance and days traveling (e.g., rehearsal and wedding days). I charge a \$100 travel fee for weddings in Buellton, Solvang, Santa Ynez, Los Olivos, and Carpinteria. I also perform weddings in Lompoc, Santa Maria, Ventura, Oxnard, Camarillo, Moorpark, Ojai, and other locations; please contact me to discuss travel rates outside the Santa Barbara area.
