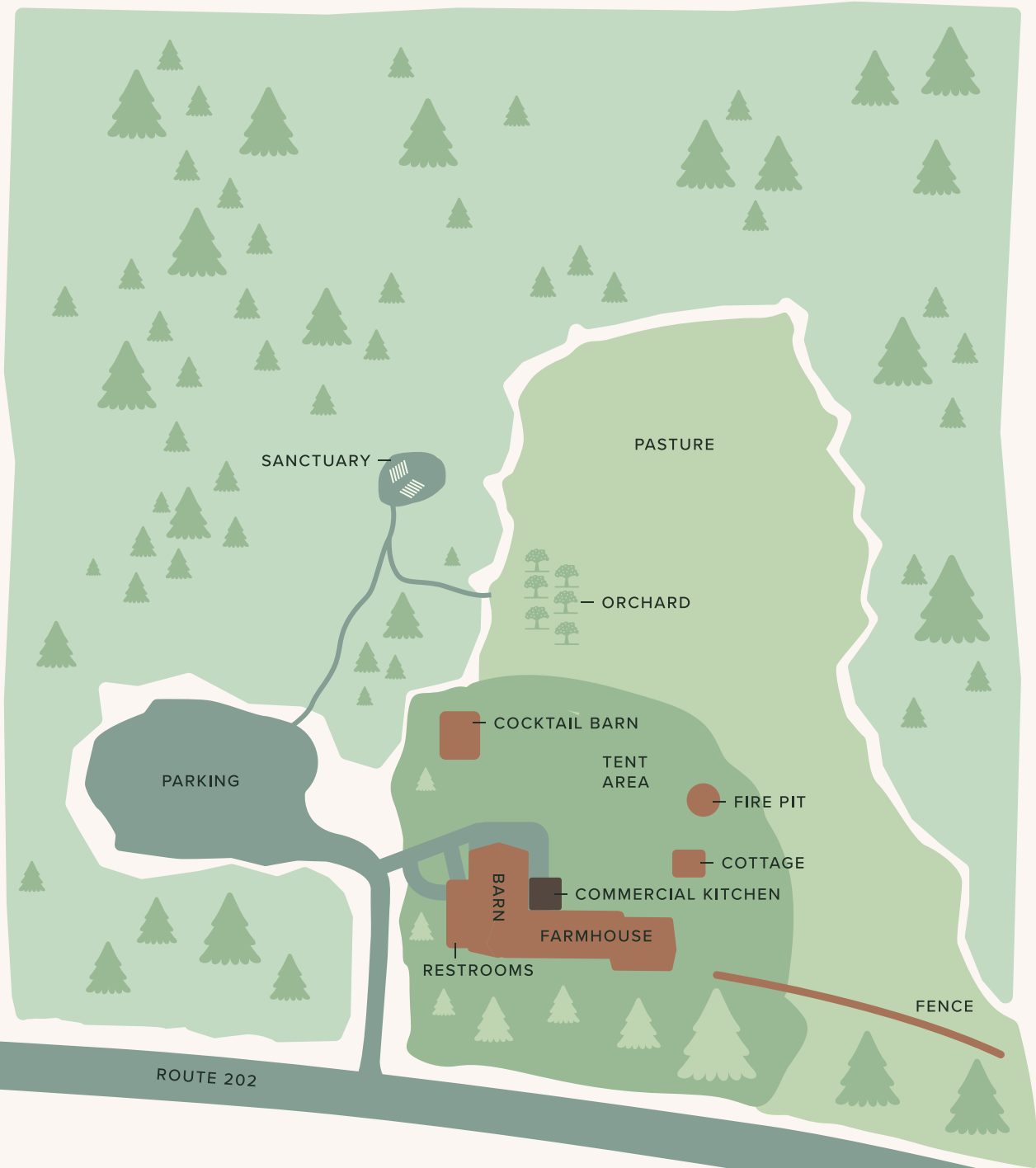

Echoes of the property’s agrarian past are present and preserved in the brilliant restoration and renovation of the attached 19th-century barn and farmhouse and unadulterated pasture. Located just twenty-five minutes southwest of Portland, Flanagan Farm offers an unforgettable backdrop to host your event, whether it is an intimate gathering, grandiose celebration, or somewhere in between.

From May through November, Flanagan Farm exclusively offers full property rentals from Thursday — Sunday for an immersive and exceptionally private wedding weekend experience. For couples interested in a Friday or Sunday celebration, dates of stay can certainly be adjusted. Specific property features and inclusions are detailed further below.

Between December–March, Flanagan Farm offers couples a unique opportunity to host their wedding at the property with a number of additional amenities included which are exclusive to the winter season.

Flanagan Farm is also thrilled to partner with Big Tree Catering, the team behind Eventide Oyster Co. and The Honey Paw, to offer incredible event menus that have been exclusively curated for winter weddings at the farm.



December–March

Winter wedding weekends at Flanagan Farm include dedicated, exclusive use of both the main barn and farmhouse from Friday–Sunday of your chosen weekend.

FLANAGAN FARM: THE BARN

With its two-and-a-half story vaulted ceiling and open 2,400 square feet of entertaining space, Flanagan Farm, meticulously restored in 2012, comfortably accommodates up to 160 guests for a seated dinner, or up to 250 guests for mingling and dancing. Modern, elevated sconces and three custom, sophisticated chandeliers radiate a warm elegance throughout. Special features in our unique 19th century space include modernized amenities like separate power for extra sound systems and a heating and cooling system to keep guests comfortable in any temperature.

The former chicken coop, fully open to the barn, has been redesigned as a stunning feature bar with reclaimed barn wood, Carrera marble counter tops, a vintage slate sink and floor-to-ceiling wine storage enclosed by custom cabinetry. The lofted lounge, located just above the bar and accessed by a grand staircase from the barn, is furnished with a leather Chesterfield sofa, a pair of overstuffed, striped chairs and a vintage Turkish Kilim rug.

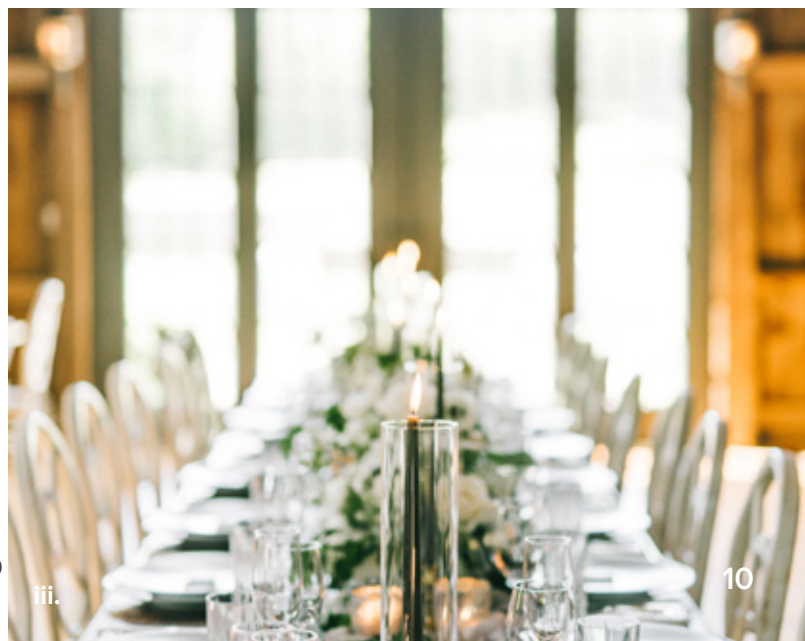
The custom, twelve-foot windowed rear barn doors open onto a blue stone patio, manicured grounds and a cleared undulating six-acre pasture, or to dinner and cocktail tents should you choose to have them.

Also overlooking the pasture, the Cocktail Barn, constructed in 2015, provides an additional 900 square feet of entertaining space. Perfect for cocktails, rehearsal dinners, late night festivities, or brunches, this versatile space makes for seamless and easy hosting over the course of your entire stay.

FLANAGAN FARM: THE GROUNDS

The sixty-six acres of Flanagan Farm were designated a Forever Farm by Maine Farmland Trust in 2011. Within the estate, the wide and dramatic, six-acre rolling pasture provides ample space for dining and cocktail tents, room for play, pear and apple trees, and white flowering plants. The secluded and enchanting ceremony grove, accessible by two winding, custom-designed boardwalks, is perfect for those desiring open-air ceremonies in a natural setting. The blue stone patio, outdoor fire pit, and family seating area invite sumptuous meals al fresco and all-season lounging.

THE FARMHOUSE

The sophisticated 2,400 square foot farmhouse, re-imagined and refined by Brooklyn-based interior designers Nastasi Vail Design, offers fully furnished accommodations for up to ten guests. The luxurious and tranquil home provides a stunningly comfortable place to unwind and prepare for your event. The three-season cottage, which sleeps an additional two guests, is located just off the exterior of the house. It is the perfect retreat—featuring an outdoor shower and views of the serene pasture. The chef's kitchen is fully equipped with two dishwashers and farm sinks, Carrera marble counter tops, a soapstone island, and houses dinnerware for up to twenty-four guests.

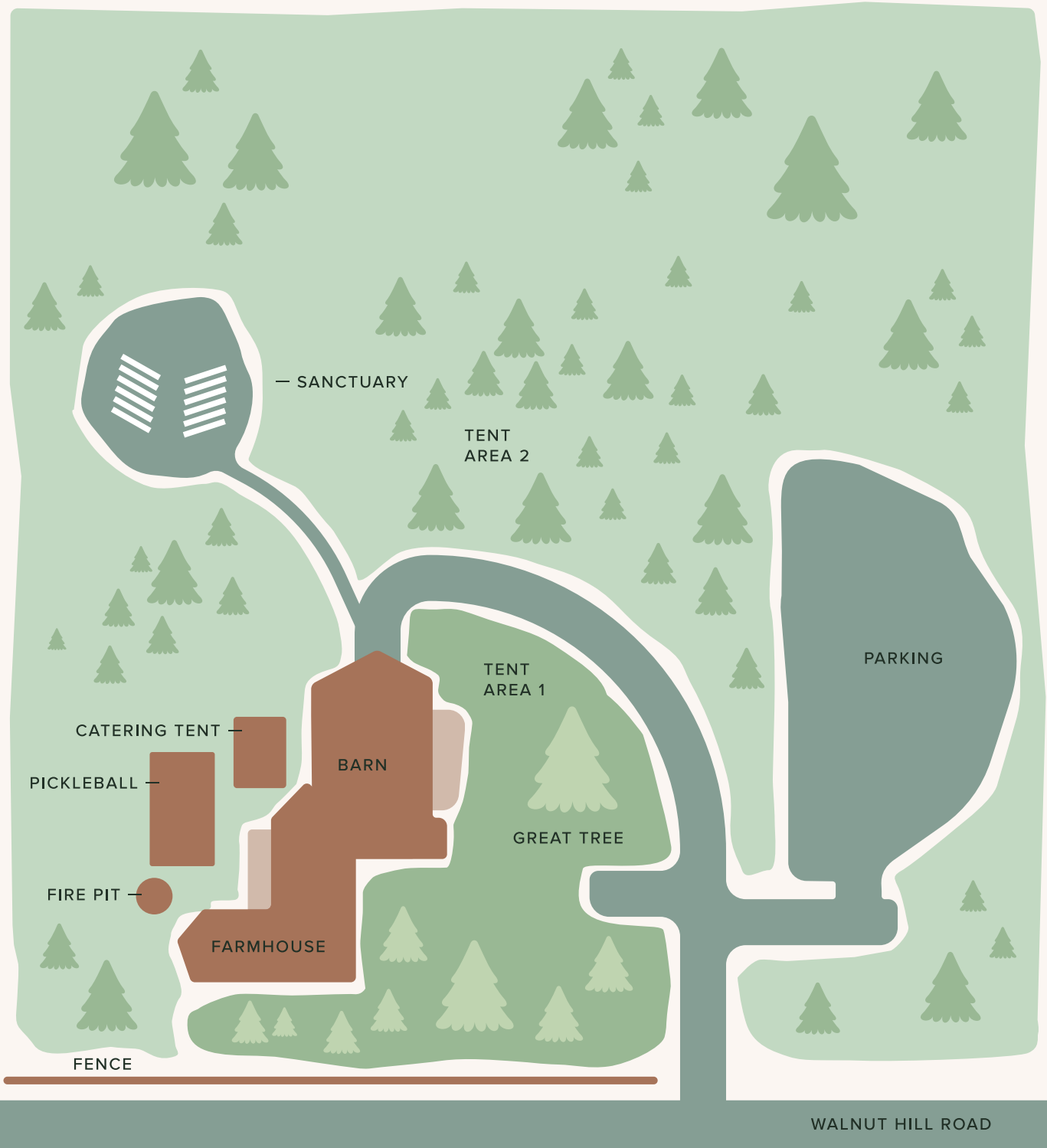


WALNUT HILL

The serene and beautifully manicured four acre estate at Walnut Hill offers an intimate setting to host your event from May through November. Located just twenty-five minutes northwest of Portland in the quiet town of North Yarmouth, the custom-designed gardens provide an enchanting backdrop for your celebration in spring, summer or fall. The attached 19th-century barn and farmhouse have been painstakingly restored and renovated to capture the charm of times past while simultaneously offering modern amenities to facilitate flawless events.

WALNUT HILL THE BARN

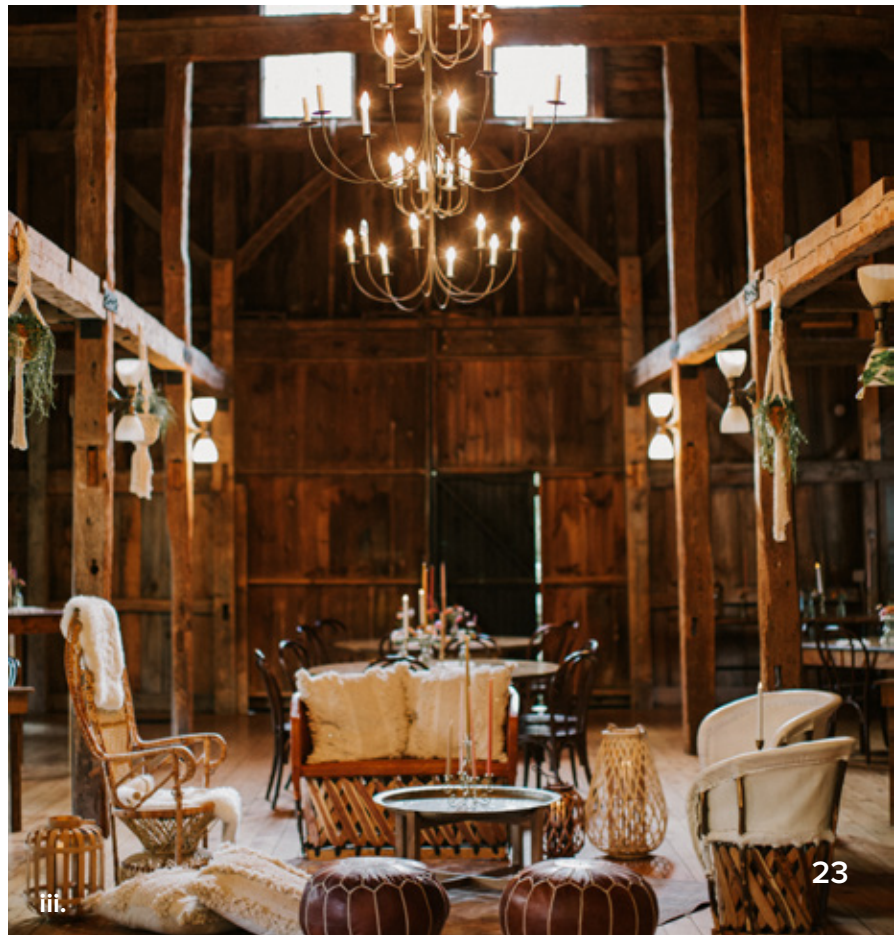
With its two-and-a-half story vaulted ceiling and open 1,800 square feet of entertaining space, Walnut Hill comfortably accommodates up to 140 guests for a seated dinner or up to 200 for mingling and dancing. Crowned by an iconic rooftop cupola, the post and beam structure is warmly lit by hand-wrought chandeliers and glass sconces. The former chicken coop, fully open to the barn, is now home to an elegant bar featuring a two-tap draft system, crafted from reclaimed barn wood, furnished with vintage tractor seat stools, and featuring a large soapstone sink. Two pairs of French doors, accessible by both the barn and bar, open onto a classic granite patio (which can be tented) for savoring cocktails with a view to the beautifully manicured grounds and gardens. Special features in our unique 19th-century space include modern amenities like separate power for sound systems, extra lighting, and a heating and cooling system to keep guests comfortable in any temperature.

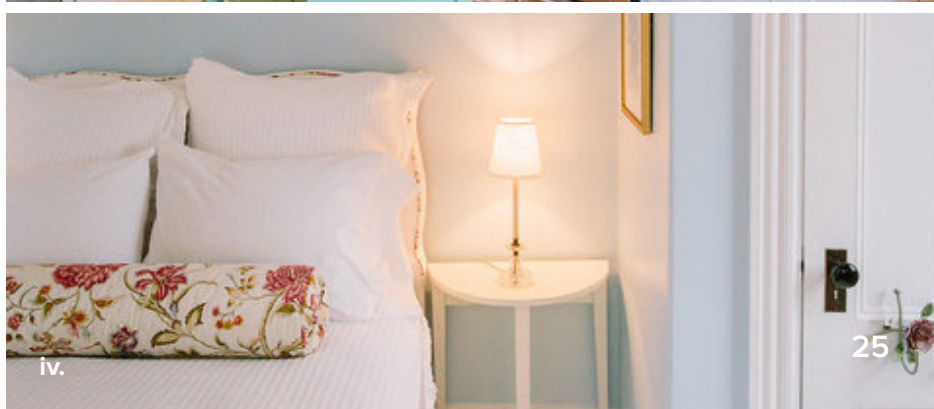

FAQ:

Do you welcome couples of all races, ethnicities, sexual orientations, genders, ages, and religious or spiritual persuasions?

Yes! We celebrate love, full stop. Our personal values are grounded deeply in equity, inclusion, and anti-racism. It's essential for us that these values always translate into a sincere sense of welcome, respect, and belonging for all of our couples, their families, and guests.

Can I schedule a time to tour one or both of the properties?

Yes, we love nothing more than showing couples and/or their families the properties as each has its own distinct personality and charms.

Between early November and the end of April, we offer tours Monday through Saturday. From May through October, to ensure privacy for couples that are getting married at our properties, we typically offer tours only after 2pm on Sunday through to 12pm the following Thursday.

Please submit an inquiry on our website if you would like to learn more or schedule a visit. We know it can be tricky to plan for site visits, so we will do our best to accommodate you whenever you might need to visit. We're excited to connect!

Do you offer late fall, winter, or spring weddings?

Yes, we host weddings at Flanagan Farm year-round and can sometimes be a bit more flexible with our property rental period in the months of December through March. Please touch base with us if you'd like to discuss planning a wedding at this time of year. Walnut Hill offers weddings from May-November only.

Are the barns climate controlled?

Yes, both barns have air-conditioning as well as heating.

How many guests can I have at my wedding?

Because both properties have large barns and ample acreage, you have options!

At Flanagan Farm, our main barn is suitable for dinner service for 160 without a dance floor, and for up to 140 if you would like to reserve space for a dance floor. You are welcome to incorporate a tent into your plan, which can make for a stunning event for up to 250 people.

At Walnut Hill, our barn is suitable for dinner service for 140 without a dance floor, and for up to 120 if you would like to reserve space for a dance floor. We have ample space for tenting on the property at Walnut Hill, which allows us to increase our capacity for events up to 200 people.

Can we have a tent at our wedding and is this included?

Yes, many of our couples opt to include some element of tenting in their wedding. This might be tenting to provide a shaded option for your guests during cocktail hour or tenting that's suitable for hosting an outdoor dinner. Also, incorporating tenting into your event helps to ensure that rain or shine, you'll be able to design a flow for the day that all of your guests will enjoy. Because the tenting needs and aesthetic preferences of each of our couples is different, we do not provide tenting. We can refer you to excellent local rental companies to make these arrangements.

How long is the property rental period?

From May through November, we offer one exclusive wedding per weekend, and the entire property is yours from midday Thursday to midday Sunday. You are welcome to host your rehearsal dinner, welcome drinks, farewell brunch, or any other experience that you might dream up on-site. Between December and March, we are able to offer full weekend rentals or shorter lengths of stay for events at Flanagan Farm.

FAQ:

Do you require that couples work with a planner or day-of coordinator?

We do. We have been hosting weddings at both properties for more than a decade and have learned that both our couples and their guests have the best, most seamless experiences when a wedding professional is on-site to manage communication with vendors and the overall flow of the day and evening.

We have worked with a number of talented planning professionals who know our properties like the back of their hand and we would be very happy to help you connect with them to see who might be the right fit for you.

Can I select my own vendors?

It is so important to select the vendors that are best positioned to bring your vision to life and we want you to have the freedom to do just that. We are happy to recommend a number of best-in-class vendors in each category (e.g. catering, rentals, floral) who have helped create truly beautiful and unique events at our properties.

If you would like to collaborate with a vendor who has not worked at our properties in the past, we would welcome the conversation with you and the professional. We are open to case by case exceptions, assuming that we have an opportunity to connect and align on our expectations for collaboration, communication, and care for the property.

What is the maximum number of people who can stay overnight at the farmhouse?

Each property is suitable for twelve overnight guests. At Flanagan Farm, the farmhouse has four bedrooms that can sleep ten guests and an additional three-season cottage that sleeps two. Walnut Hill has five bedrooms which can comfortably sleep twelve guests.

We kindly request that you refrain from inviting additional overnight guests. With the safety of your wedding guests in mind, our property manager will be on-site until the end of your celebration to ensure that all non-overnight guests have made their way safely home at the end of the evening.

Where should our guests stay?

Both Flanagan Farm and Walnut Hill are 25 minutes from downtown Portland. You can find wonderful hotels from all the major hotel groups in Portland, most of whom are willing to offer hotel blocks for your guests.

Shuttle transportation can also be arranged for easy pick up and drop off to these locations.

Outside of Portland, the charming town of Freeport is 20 minutes from Walnut Hill, and Biddeford, with a number of major hotel groups, is 20 minutes from Flanagan Farm.

Do you offer any options for late night?

At Flanagan Farm, we ask that music wrap-up by 10:30pm but you also have the option of extending your party to 11:30pm for an additional fee. At Walnut Hill, music must be wrapped-up by 10:30pm, with guests departing no later than 11pm. The times at Walnut Hill cannot be extended.

As two of the closest wedding venues to Portland, another great option is to continue the party at one of Portland's incredible bars or restaurants for a few more hours.

Can I provide my own beer, wine, or alcohol?

Yes. If you do, we will ask that you acquire "host liquor liability" insurance, which is typically included in most general liability insurance policies. These policies are very simple to secure online or through a local insurance provider, and we are happy to point you in the right direction. We do require that you utilize a licensed and insured bartending or catering company to oversee and execute service.

How do I book a date?

To reserve a date, we require both a signed contract and a completed first payment of 50% of the total booking price. Subsequent payments will take place nine months before your event (25%) and three months before your event (25%).
